Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for quashing of the impugned order dated 13.03.2012 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned ACJM, SBS Nagar, whereby the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender in case FIR No.121, dated 11.08.2009, registered under Sections 406, 420, 34 IPC, at Police Station City SBS Nagar, District SBS Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had mistakenly noted the wrong date as 13.04.2012 and when on the noted date i.e. 13.04.2012, he appeared before the trial Court, only then he came to know that non-bailable warrants had been issued against him and subsequently order of proclamation had also been issued against him on 13.03.2012 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner enquired the aforesaid fact from his counsel and came to know that the same date i.e. 13.04.2012 had been noted with his counsel at the lower Court as well. The absence of the petitioner is neither willful nor intentional and he is ready to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.

3. Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. A. A. Pathak, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is

present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 – State and Mr. Ankur Bansal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 – complainant. Let requisite copies of the complete paper book be supplied to the learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 during the course of the day.

5. Keeping in view the submission made above, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on or before 12.06.2019 and on his appearance, the trial Court shall consider his prayer for bail, expeditiously, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
