1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite the petitioner having submitted representation dated 14.1.2019 (Annexure P-7) to the respondent for correction of the name of the petitioner, name of the mother as also date of birth as per record submitted by the petitioner, no decision in respect thereto has been taken by the respondent till date.

2. Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation dated 14.1.2019 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. K.K. Gupta, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

5. In the light of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, writ petition

is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the

representation dated 14.1.2019 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with rules and regulations applicable as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
