The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 439(2) read with Section 482 Cr.PC for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.1 vide order dated 31.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind in case bearing FIR No.178 dated 31.08.2018 (wrongly mentioned as 13.08.2018) under Sections 313, 354-D, 376(2) (n) and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Jind.

Prayer has also been made for setting aside the order dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-9), whereby the application filed by the petitioner for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.1 was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind.

Perusal of the impugned order dated 31.10.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind reveals that in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.PC the victim has admitted that she was in live-in

relationship with the petitioner for about 7 years and despite the marriage of the petitioner, she continued her physical relationship with the petitioner-accused. Moreover, while granting bail to the petitioner, learned Additional Sessions Judge has also taken into consideration the fact that the complainant/victim is major and educated person and investigation in the case is complete and the petitioner was in custody since 02.09.2018.

Therefore, this Court finds that no ground is made out for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.1 vide order dated 31.10.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind. The application for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.1 has rightly been dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind vide impugned order dated 22.04.2019.

The present petition, being devoid of any merit, is accordingly, dismissed.
