The present writ petition has been filed by a dealer of the Indian Oil Corporation Limited (Corporation) challenging the withdrawal of the 'NOC' granted by the District Magistrate, in favour of Corporation, qua the site where the outlet was located.

In view of the fact that the Corporation has taken a decision to re-locate the said site of the outlet to an alternative location, the issue of withdrawing the 'NOC' in favour of Corporation qua the old location has become insignificant.

In view thereof, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous.
