ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 79 dated 08.05.2019, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City-I, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that a sum of ₹50,000/- was paid by the complainant to the petitioner for sending the son and nephew of the complainant to Cyprus. He also contends that the son and the nephew of the complainant were sent to Cyprus and they returned on their own and were not deported. He further contends that the petitioner is a 67 years old lady and is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by the order dated 29.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 29.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
