Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the Central Board of Secondary Education to carry out a correction in the 10<sup>th</sup> and 10+2 examination certificates and for his name to read as Prashant Barjati instead of Prashant.

Pleadings on record would show that even though there is no challenge to the same, yet, such request has already been dealt with by the C.B.S.E vide communication dated 13.5.2019 (Annexure P-8) and has been declined.

Perusal of the impugned communication would reveal even a basis of rejection i.e. “the school record does not support the desired correction”.

On a specific query having been put, counsel concedes that as of date the school in which the petitioner had studied and had participated in the 10<sup>th</sup> and 10+2 examination have not been updated.

In view of the above, there is no infirmity in the communication dated 13.5.2019 (Annexure P-8).

No intervention, as such, is called for.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to approach the school concerned seeking the necessary correction along with all the requisite documents.

In the eventuality of the school records being updated in terms of the prayer made in the instant petition, it would be open for the petitioner to carry the prayer further to the C.B.S.E.

Disposed of.
