Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of direction to respondent No. 3-DSP, NRI Cell, Ludhiana not to harass the petitioners on a complaint given by respondent No. 6/Kamaljeet Kaur, daughter-in-law of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2, who is residing in Canada, and in case of registration of any FIR, the petitioners be given advance notice considering the fact that they are senior citizens.

Admittedly, no FIR has been registered against the petitioners and it is specifically stated in the petition itself that DSP, NRI Cell, Ludhiana is only conducting an inquiry on the complaint given by respondent No. 6, therefore, neither any fault is found in the procedure adopted by DSP, NRI Cell, Ludhiana, who has called the petitioners by issuing a notice to associate them in the inquiry and till date, no FIR is registered.

Therefore, I find no ground to issue any direction to the respondents.

The petitioners are bound to face the inquiry in terms of the notices given by the DSP, NRI Cell, Ludhiana and in the event of registration of any FIR, they will have the remedy to apply for grant of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, this petition is hereby dismissed.
