Arguing counsel for the petitioner was neither present on the last date of hearing nor today.

The prayer in the present petition is for conducting proper and fair investigation in case FIR No.0073 dated 22.08.2017 registered under Sections 302, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Rureke Kalan on the ground that a single accused has not been arrested whereas they were named specifically.

In response to notice of motion, the reply has been filed, which is already on record.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply/status report and also on instructions from ASI Bhola Singh, submits that there is a progress in the investigation as not only the challan has been presented but the charges have also been framed. He further submits that total nine

prosecution witnesses have been examined and the trial is in progress.

Keeping in view the stand and submissions made by learned State counsel and also the fact that the trial is in progress as total nine prosecution witnesses have already been examined, the present petition has become infructuous.
