In respect of its grievance against various persons who are stated to be 'running' the Gandhi Samarak Nidhi Trust at Sector 16, Chandigarh, the petitioner is shown to have got issued a legal notice to the DGP, Chandigarh, the SSP, Chandigarh, and the SHO, Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-34 with the petition.

Consequently, without making any comment on the correctness or otherwise of the allegations made, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, i.e. respondent no.2, to look into the grievance and to have the matter thoroughly enquired into, and to take a decision thereafter within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Naturally, the petitioner and not its Advocate (unless the petitioner and its Advocate so choose), would be heard by the SSP.
