Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 to 6 by providing adequate police protection and also direct respondents No.2 & 3 not to harass the petitioner illegally at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had moved a representation to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, annexed herewith as Annexure P-1, alleging harassment at the hands of the respondents, who had been demanding a sum of ₹5.00 lakhs and further threatening the petitioner that in case, he failed to make the aforementioned payment, he would have to face dire consequences of the same.

Heard.

A perusal of the representation Annexure P-1 reveals that the said representation is 'undated'. The petitioner may take recourse to any other remedy if available under the law *qua* the allegations made in the petitioner.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to invoke the inherent powers envisaged under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
