TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the writ paper book has been perused.

Apparently, the bone of contention is a piece of land that the petitioner is stated to have purchased in the year 2007 and having constructed a temple thereupon. Allegations are that the private respondents are wanting to grab such property and pursuant to such evil design are threatening to kill the petitioner.

During the course of arguments, counsel would concede that the land in question already stands acquired and falls within the green belt area as per the relevant HUDA sector plan.

Counsel has not been able to demonstrate to this Court any vested and legitimate right of the petitioner on the land in question.

That apart, the averments in the petition as regards the threat perception are utterly vague.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
