Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0001 dated 03.01.2018 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 15.02.2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has prepared cancellation report and submitted the same to the concerned court on 18.04.2018. However, the court has ordered reinvestigation in the case. As a result thereof, fresh

process of being filed before the court.

In view of the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and the police has prepared cancellation report, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 15.02.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

As regard the apprehension of the counsel for the complainant that there is an immediate threat to the complainant, the complainant is at liberty to approach the authority concerned for the relief.
