The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the private respondents i.e. respondents No.5 to 10 have duped a large number of persons on the pretext of sending them abroad. It has been submitted that some such persons including the petitioners had also been duped of huge amount and although they had made representations to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar to look into the matter and to dispose of the representations, which have been annexed as a compilation with this petition as Annexure P-1, in accordance with law, at the earliest. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps be taken thereupon at the earliest.

respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
