Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that arbitration award with respect to the dispute raised by the U.T. Administration was decided on 18.06.2013 and two applications had been filed by the U.T. Administration. One application for execution was dismissed in default on 31.10.2015 and restoration application of the execution was withdrawn on 02.07.2016 (Annexure P-6). A fresh execution application has now been filed before the Court of Id. District Judge (Principal Civil Court) Mohali, S.A.S. Nagar on 28.11.2016 (Annexure P-7). Petitioners have filed their objections to the execution application (Annexure P-8) and reply to the objections has been filed by the U.T. Administration (Annexure P-9). Thereafter rejoinder to the reply has been filed on 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-10).

The grievance of the petitioners is that he is 80 year old senior citizen and after filing rejoinder on 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-10) and till date preliminary objections with respect to maintainability of the execution application at Mohali is not being decided.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the Court of Id. District Judge (Principal Civil Court) Mohali, S.A.S. Nagar to

decide the maintainability of execution application within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
