As agreed, as per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the respondent – insurance company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹2,40,000/- (₹ Two Lac Forty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. This is subject to all just exceptions available in favour of the respondent – insurance company.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the insurance company to deposit the crossed–cheques of the enhanced amount of ₹2,40,000/- in names of the appellants in the same ratio as awarded by the MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.07.2019, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – insurance company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.
