Pawan Kumar-appellant, aged about 24 years has filed the present appeal against the total award of ₹27,071/-, passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jhajjar (for short 'MACT') dated 13.03.2006 seeking enhancement of compensation on account of the injuries including disability received by him in a motor vehicular accident that had taken place on 14.02.2003.

Learned counsel for the appellant contends that appellant is young man of 24 years and remained admitted in hospital for about 2 weeks and undertaken operation and suffered disability to the extent of 18%. The MACT has fallen in error in awarding ₹10,000/- under this head. It is further contended that a meagre amount of ₹5,000/- under the head of 'pain and suffering' which requires substantial increase and no amount of compensation under the head of 'attendant' though he remained admitted in hospital for about 2 weeks. He contends that though the enhancement comes to more than ₹1,00,000/- but the appellant would be satisfied if another sum of ₹60,000/- more, over and above, the amount already awarded by the MACT concerned, is granted to the appellant in full and
