Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.6 on the basis of representation dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.6 lured the petitioner and his brother to pay ₹ 16,50,000/- for arranging Canadian visa as she had links with the concerned Embassy. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to look into the representation dated 02.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.4-Sr. Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the representation dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The present petition stands disposed off.
