As per pleadings on record, petitioner had applied for the post of Steno-Typist in response to an advertisement dated 18.9.2014.

A written test was conducted on 22.3.2015 in which petitioner had appeared and in the result that was declared in the month of April, 2015 the petitioner's name appeared at Sr. No.8 in the order of merit. The short grievance raised in the petition is that no further steps have been taken pursuant to the selection process initiated vide advertisement dated 18.9.2014.

Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to finalize the selection process.

Having heard learned senior counsel and keeping in view the limited prayer raised in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same at the very threshold with a direction to the appropriate authority under the respondent Corporation to look into the matter and to take further steps as may be warranted in accordance with law.
