By this petition, the petitioner is seeking promotion as per length of his service whereas his juniors have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order/letter dated 06.12.2013 (Annexure P-2) whereby enquiry proceedings initiated against the petitioner were dropped and the petitioner was exonerated. He was also entitled to all the benefits as provided by Rule 7.3 of Punjab Civil Services Rules (Haryana), Vol-I, Part-I and suspension period of the petitioner had been treated as duty period for all intents and purposes.

The grievance of the petitioner is that now after this order dated 06.12.2013 (Annexure P-2), he is not being considered for promotion and his juniors have been promoted to the post of Headmaster.

The petitioner has given legal notice dated 14.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) and representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A copy of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
