GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this court seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is stated to be harassed by respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner had entered into an agreement with one Mukhtiar Singh to purchase agricultural land and had paid approximately an amount of ₹ 27 lacs as earnest money and the petitioner had been handed over possession of the land in question. It has been submitted that the aforesaid Mukhtiar Singh however, did not execute the sale deed in time despite the fact that the petitioner was willing to perform his part of the contract. It has further been submitted that Mukhtiar

Singh did not do the needful for getting the property redeemed which was stated to be mortgaged with the bank and that on the other hand said Mukhtiar Singh (respondent No.4), in connivance with respondents No.5 to 7 are attempting to forcibly dispossess the petitioner and are trying to cause harm to him.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, Punjab (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 2.5.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. Further, in case it is found that there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-3 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, Punjab (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
