Prayer in present writ petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 4.5.2006 (Annexure P-3) vide which services of petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 04.05.2006 instead of 01.01.1999 i.e. date juniors have been regularized, vide order dated 12.03.2018 and 18.10.2018, respectively.

Notice of motion.

On asking of Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Mr.S.K.Malik, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and decide legal notice dated 16.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) within some specified time.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without going into merit of case or commenting thereon, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the legal notice dated 16.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) by passing a well reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, representation is not decided within aforementioned specified time, there shall be costs of Rs.50,000/- to be paid by the concerned officer to the petitioner.
