AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.144 dated 05.09.2017 registered under Sections 21.4(1) of Mines and Minerals Act at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamunanagar at Jagadhri.

On 16.02.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 13.3.2018.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on ad interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall loose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Rajiv Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 16.02.2018 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
