The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 26.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 18370 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 09.05.2018 (P-9) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.”

A short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Atul Pasrija, Superintending Engineer (HR), DHBVN, Hisar, filed in Court today, is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the reply filed in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous.

While disposing of writ petition, the petitioners were granted liberty to have recourse to remedies available under the law. Needless to say that in case, the petitioners still have any grievance, they would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
