This petition has been filed by the petitioner/complainant with a prayer that the direction be issued to respondents No.2 and 3 for looking into the complaints given by him and taking legal action against the accused persons.

The complaint dated 06.02.2014 contained the allegations of illegal withdrawal from the savings accounts of the complainant and according to him, a sum of ₹2,90,000/- was withdrawn on 12.12.2013. According to the complainant, the said amount was not withdrawn by him. Annexure P-2 is the second complaint on the same subject which echoes the voice of previous one.

In response to the petition, reply by way of affidavit of Narinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District

Ferozepur was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, wherein it was mentioned that the complaints were looked into and the said amount was withdrawn on the strength of the vouchers duly filled in and signed by the complainant.

Considering the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
