Present petition has been filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“(a) Under the present circumstances the petitioner humbly prays that the present petition may kindly be allowed and directions may be issued to respondents No.2 and 3 from restraining to register a false case against the petitioner and his family members in connection with FIR No. 193 dated 3.11.2016 at P.S. Phase 1 Mohali under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at the complaint of the petitioner.

For directing the respondent No.3 to produce on record the report of investigation conducted with respect to above stated FIR No.193 dated 3.11.2016 before this Hon'ble Court.

For directing the respondent no.2 to transfer the investigation in the above stated FIR to an independent senior officer, in the interest of justice.”
