SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 460 dated 29.10.2017 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 27.10.2017. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as large number of PWs remained to be examined. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and keeping in view his custody period, petitioner deserves to be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, at Chandigarh.
