AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.342 dated 17.08.2017 registered under Sections 136 E.C. Act and 304-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Fatehabad.

On 20.02.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the challan has been submitted.

Notice of motion for 13.3.2018.

Mr. Amit Rana, Advocate has appeared for the complainant and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

Let the record of the trial court be summoned.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on ad interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to

the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Randhir Singh accepts the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 20.02.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
