The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.10.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-46156 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 8.8.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Short reply dated 20.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Mr. Bhupinder Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka annexing copy of FIR dated 14.7.2019 filed in court is taken on record,

copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that representation dated 8.8.2018 given by the petitioner has been objectively considered and thereafter FIR has been registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be granted liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law, in case the grievance still survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
