AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 24.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.6187 of 2017.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is allowed and respondents are directed to accept option of the petitioner for assistance as per 2006 policy. The necessary benefits be released to the petitioner w.e.f. the year 2006 within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with 8% interest and thereafter, information in this regard be sent to this Court.”

Learned State counsel has produced order dated 28.08.2019 passed by respondent No.1, same is taken on record. Copy of order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per said order, sanction has been accorded for monthly financial assistance which is equal to the pay and other allowances that was last drawn by Late Constable Dharam Singh.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that following eight documents are required to be furnished by the petitioner in order to release the monthly financial assistance:

1. *Date of birth of Smt. Savitri Devi (Wife of Late Ct. Dharampal)*
2. *PPO No. (Smt. Savitri Devi)*
3. *Bank Account Number (Smt. Savitri Devi)*
4. *IFSC Code (Smt. Savitri Devi)*
5. *Pan Number (Smt. Savitri Devi)*
6. *Name of father and mother (Smt. Savitri Devi)*
7. *Pension revised order PNB Bank (with detail) on 01.01.2006.*
8. *Pension revised Order PNB Bank (with details) on 01.01.2006.*

List of the documents has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that documents will be furnished.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that on furnishing of all the documents, needful would be done expeditiously and not later than four weeks from the date of receipt of documents.

In view of reply filed and statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.
