In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 11.12.2009 by which, the respondents had mentioned that the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Foreman Instructor w.e.f. 22.08.2007 will be considered in the next DPC.

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that during the pendency of the present writ petition, vide order dated 03.02.2012, the benefit which was being sought by the petitioner, has already been released to him i.e. promotion to the post of Foreman Instructor w.e.f. 22.08.2007.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said order has not been implemented so far and the pension has not been revised so far in view of the order dated 03.02.2012. He further states that unfortunately the petitioner died on 20.02.2013 after which, his wife namely Charanjit Kaur is entitled for the family pension also.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the appropriate direction be given to the respondents to implement the order dated 03.02.2012 in letter and spirit.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the order dated 03.02.2012 will be implemented and the consequential relief, for which the petitioner or his legal heirs are entitled for including the grant of family pension, will be released to them within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order if not already released.

In view of the undertaking given by counsel for the respondents, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition any further.

The present writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
