Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioner in terms of representation (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.4 to 9 has stated that in fact son of the petitioner was engaged to the daughter of respondent No.6 namely Prem Paul. However, the said alliance could not be materialized and engagement was called off. Learned counsel further submits that thereafter the son of the petitioner has started making objectionable posts by pasting photos of daughter of respondent No.6 and his wife by raising a finger on her character, as a result of which, FIR is registered against the son of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that as a counter blast to the said FIR, the present petition has been filed by the father of the accused with the allegation that appropriate action be taken on the representation (Annexure P-2).

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Madan Gopal Submits that the petitioner was never called by the police and the investigation of the aforesaid case is not required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above, no action is called for on the representation given by the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
