Present revision petition has been filed against detailed judgment passed by learned Court of Sessions accepting the appeal filed by the respondents No. 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Learned Court of Sessions has recorded a finding that cumulative effect of the evidence available on record, create a doubt in the correctness of the prosecution's case. The Court has noticed that Kulwant Rani w/o Raj Singh, sister-in-law of the first informant-injured has not been examined although she is alleged to be present at the spot. Medico Legal Report of Balwinder Singh has also not been proved. It has also come in evidence that first informant and Kishore Singh could not explain as to how and by whom the injuries as sustained by the accused were inflicted.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no ground to interfere. Dismissed.
