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Present appeal has been preferred by the claimants under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (*for short 'Act'*) against the impugned Award dated 10.05.2007, passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurgaon (*for short, 'Tribunal'*) for enhancement of compensation on account of death of Swaran Singh alias Sarwan Singh (*for short 'deceased'*).

Today, the matter has been listed before the National Lok Adalat.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3/Insurance Company, on instructions, has offered to pay an amount of Rs.3,60,000/- (Rupees three lakhs and sixty thousand only) over and above the compensation awarded by learned Tribunal, which is acceptable to the appellants/claimants as full and final settlement of their claim in this appeal. Statements of learned counsel for the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, we direct respondent No.3/Insurance Company to deposit the aforesaid enhanced amount of Rs.3,60,000/- (Rupees three lakhs and sixty thousand only) by way of

cheque or demand draft in the names of the appellants/claimants with the Office of Lok Adalat of this Court within four weeks from today and the same be handed over to them against proper receipt and identification, failing which, the enhanced amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of instant settlement till its realization. The terms and conditions of disbursal of the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation will remain unaltered, as passed by learned Tribunal.

FAO stands disposed of.
