Main Case

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Satish Kumar, District Elementary Education Officer, Sonapat, same is taken on record. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioners. He has also placed on record a communication dated 10.10.2019 whereby, directions have been issued to the Drawing and Disbursing Officer to re-fix the pay of all the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that most of the petitioners have retired and apart from re-fixation of pay, the pensionary benefits would also be required to be refixed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Rajeev Kumar, LA, O/o District Elementary Education Officer, Sonapat, submits that the needful would be done within four months from today, subject to the outcome of curative petition if so filed.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, it is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to file application for revival of the present petition.
