For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, delay of 27 days in filing the present revision is condoned.

Application is allowed.

Main case

After appreciating the evidence, learned Magistrate acquitted the accused which has been affirmed by the learned Court of Sessions.

Learned Court of Sessions has recorded following reasons while dismissing the appeal:-

- 1) There is no medico legal report of Bhoom Dutt, brother of the complainant who was also alleged to have been injured.
- 2) Kuku and Mohinder who are alleged to have saved first informant

from the clutches of the accused have not been examined.

- 3) Torn blood-stained clothes which were taken in possession by the police have not been produced.
- 4) Although, it is case of the prosecution that 40-50 persons assembled at the place of occurrence but not a single witness has been examined.
- 5) There are discrepancies in the statement of PW1 Suresh Chander and PW2 Bhoom Dutt.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length and with his able assistance gone through the judgments passed by the Courts below.

Although, counsel made sincere attempt, however, failed to draw attention of the Court to any substantive error or perversity in the judgments passed.

Hence, no ground to interfere.

Accordingly, the present criminal revision petition is dismissed.
