Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to take the enquiry of the FIR registered by the petitioner to its logical end.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub-Division Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural) filed in the Court today and as per the reply on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner and the MLR, case FIR No.74 dated 23.5.2018 under Sections 323/324/148/149/452 IPC was registered at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural). It is further stated that, thereafter, the enquiry was conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) and during enquiry the accused/respondents No.4 to 8 were arrested on 23.3.2019 and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared on 6.4.2019 by the Station House Officer, Police Station Ajnala and the same will be presented before the Illaqua Magistrate shortly.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Joginder Pal has stated that the challan will be presented within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the above, the Station House Officer, Ajnala is directed to present the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. within a period of four weeks from today.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
