ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.(ORAL) :

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 8, on the representation/complaint (Annexure P2).

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Model Town), (4), Jalandhar, dated 10.01.2019, filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per reply, it is stated that the petitioner is habitual of filing similar complaints. On earlier occasions, three complaints were inquired into by the police. It is further stated that even the present complaint has also been inquired into and it is found that in fact, the petitioner is filing the complaints as he is facing trial in FIR No.172 dated 14.12.2017, under Sections 323/324 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, on the basis of a complaint given by his wife i.e.respondent No.5 and the said case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a complaint before the Illaqa Magistrate, if so advised.
