Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioner having represented to the respondents to treat her case in accordance with Standing Order No. 07/2015, which is the Transfer Policy specially enacted for Mahila Personnel serving in CRPF, her representations have not been considered. He has drawn my attention to Annexure P-7 whereby similarly situated Mahila Personnel have been given the benefit of said policy. Learned counsel for the petitioner in particular relies on sub clause(e) of clause 12 of the Transfer Policy *ibid*.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Ms.Anita Balyan, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that advance copy of the petition has already been served on her.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the writ

petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in light of the Standing Order No.07/2015 dated 04.08.2015 governing the transfer of Non-Gazetted (Executive/Technical/Tradesmen) Force Personnel including Mahila Personnel. Till the passing of the speaking order as stated above, the operation of the transfer order dated 11.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) impugned herein shall remain stayed.

5. Petition disposed of in the above terms.
