Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.136 dated 28.12.2015 under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 120-B IPC and Sections 3 & 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 06.08.2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their

custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.08.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
