This case was taken up on 25.02.2016 for the first time and it was observed by this Court that since the petitioner has not surrendered after his conviction, counsel will address arguments on the maintainability of the instant revision petition. Subsequent thereto, on various stages, it was noticed that the petitioner has not surrendered.

On 28.09.2016, the application moved by the petitioner seeking suspension of his sentence was dismissed noticing the aforesaid facts and the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala was directed to execute the judgment of conviction, which was affirmed by the lower Appellate Court. Again, on 14.02.2018 and 04.02.2019, it was noticed that the petitioner has not surrendered.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the certificate, issued by the Superintendent of Central Jail, Patiala dated 09.07.2019 to the effect that till date, the petitioner has not yet surrendered.

In view of the same, this petition is hereby dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition only after he has surrendered before the jail authorities.
