Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to direct respondent No.4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

A perusal of the petition shows that respondents No.5 and 6 have filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Baljinder Singh submits that the representation given by the petitioner has been duly inquired into by the DSP (D), Mansa and it is found that the matter is subjudice before the Court and there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered infructuous at this stage and is disposed of as such.
