Petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of criminal writ in the nature of habeas corpus for directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to recover/get release the detinue, namely, Sarabjeet Kaur daughter of Sukhdev Singh (petitioner), who has been kidnapped from the legal custody of her parents and has been illegally detained by respondent No.4.

It is not disputed that the said Sarabjeet Kaur brought CWP No.13424 of 2019 and sought directions for protection of life and liberty, who had allegedly entered into marriage with the co-petitioner in the said writ petition, wherein, the following order was passed :-

“Heard.

Pleadings on record have been perused.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, that in case any representation is filed seeking protection of life and liberty, the contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court for marriage of the parties.

Petition stands disposed of.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the petitioner was a respondent in the said writ petition.

In view of the above, no case is made out for issuance of any directions.

The petition is dismissed.
