This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 29.01.2019 passed in CWP No. 2392 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ Without commenting on the claim set out by the petitioners in the present petition, we would deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction that in case the petitioners submit a representation to the authorities within a period of three weeks from today setting out their grievance, the same shall be considered and decided by the authorities in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks thereafter. Ordered accordingly.”

In compliance of the order dated 22.08.2019, Dr. D. Suresh, Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula is present in Court and tendered an unconditional apology for the delay occurred in compliance of the order.

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed an affidavit of D. Suresh, Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula annexing the order dated 22.08.2019. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the matter is to be dealt with by Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (HSIIDC) and the application of the petitioner has been forwarded thereto.

In view of above and unconditional apology tendered, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue the matter with the afore-said Corporation (HSIIDC).
