Through this petition, the petitioners have prayed for quashing of the impugned complaint No. 190 dated 20.04.2012, filed under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 read with Section 120-B IPC, summoning order dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by JMIC, Faridabad under Section 420 read with Section 120-B IPC as well as order dated 06.12.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by the revisional Court, whereby the summoning of the petitioner was upheld.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that the trial in the impugned complaint ended in conviction of the petitioners through judgment dated 26.03.2019. A copy of the judgment has been produced in the Court. He further states that before the Appellate Court, the parties have compounded the offence and the Appellate Court has acquitted the petitioners on 06.12.2019.

In view of above, nothing survives for adjudication in the present case, the petition is rendered infructuous.
