Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of the order dated 21.11.2011 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned JMIC, Amritsar, vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner have already been acquitted and the petitioner is willing to undergo the trial subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- as costs.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr.DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of State. Two copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court / Duty Judicial Magistrate on or before 05.07.2019 and produce proof of deposit of a sum of Rs.50,000/- with the

High Court Legal Services, Committee. He would also be at liberty to seek regular bail and in case the aforementioned condition is fulfilled, the trial Court / Duty Judicial Magistrate concerned at Amritsar, shall allow him bail subject to its satisfaction.
