The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 24.02.2019, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 427, 506, 120-B, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, Phagwara, District Kapurthala, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein four co-accused have been specifically named and ascribed role of beating up the injured. He also contends that the CCTV footage had recorded the incident and the petitioner was not present at the spot.

This Court, by the order dated 31.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 31.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
