This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2-The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) and reminder dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, D.A.G., Haryana, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the prayer made by the petitioners is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the prayer made by the petitioners is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.

Till then the effect of Demolition Order dated 21.02.2019 (Annexure P-6) shall be kept in abeyance *qua* the present petitioners.
