GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner No.1-Raj Kaur was married to respondent No.4 on 26.3.2016 and a child was also born out of the wedlock. It has further been submitted that in fact when the marriage was solemnized, the petitioner No.1 was a minor whereas respondent No.4 was aged 38 years. It has further been submitted that respondents No.4 and 5

had however been harassing petitioner No.1 and now she out of her own accord had started residing with petitioner No.2 but respondents No.4 and 5 are threatening to cause harm to them.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law and in case, it is found that there is any imminent threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to them.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
