This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.09.2018 passed in CWP No. 24995 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal to look into and decide the representation dated 10.08.2018 (Annexure P3) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order”

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Dr. Priyanka Soni, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal-respondent annexing the order dated 14.08.2019, copy handed over to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 14.08.2019.
