As per pleadings on record, petitioner is aged 19 years, her date of birth being 27.05.2000.

A writ of mandamus is sought for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect her life and personal liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of her own parents and close relatives.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. SHO Police Station Sadar, District Yamunanagar, confined on the aspect of any threat that she faces to her life and liberty from her own parents and close relatives.

In the eventuality of any such application/representation being made by the petitioner, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into

the matter and to take steps thereafter as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
